Adult League Overview

The F1 Boston Adult Racing League offers the best value in racing available today. Competing in identical karts on a variety of tracks with other drivers in the same weight class, every driver is assured of a high level of competition. The Adult Leagues are open to all F1 Boston Competition License holders.

Rookie League

Perfect for the first-time racer or those who seek a more competitive environment to develop their skills. Open only to first time league drivers. Every night of racing features three 35-lap races with a practice before racing. Five of the six rounds will count towards the final league championship.

Sprint League

Every night of racing features four 30-lap races with a practice before racing. Only the driver's best three races will be scored for the night. Their lowest scored race of the night will be dropped. Five of the six rounds will count towards the final league championship.

Weight Classes - All drivers are required to weigh in prior to the start of the league. Each league will be broken down into different weight classes with a driver carrying weight in their kart up to the max weight set for that class. This will ensure a fair and competitive race.

Points Structure - During each round of the league, competitors take part in one practice session and three races in the Rookie League and four races in the Sprint League. Competitors will start races from the fair sections of the grid over the course of the season. Race winners are awarded 14 points; second place 12 points with 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 and 0 points for third through eleventh place respectively. The driver achieving the fastest lap in each race will pick up an extra point. Five of the six rounds will count towards the final league championship.

League Finals - The top three drivers from each weight class will receive awards. The top eight drivers in each weight class will be invited back to the Final Championship Race. All drivers must have competed in five rounds. The fee for the finals is not included in the price for each league.

Pro- League

F1 Boston's Pro-League. This league is specially designed for drivers who are looking for the ultimate racing experience. Each driver will experience tight and seriously competitive racing. Every lap. Every race.

Mandatory Qualifier Session Friday, December 16 th Track 1	Any driver wishing to participate in the Pro-League must attend the mandatory qualifying session on Friday, December 16th. 6:30pm arrival - 7:30 pm race A competition license is not required to race in the qualifier. Drivers must have raced in two or more adult race series prior to joining the pro league.

Qualifying and Starting Grids:

Each night will start with a timed practice/qualifying session with a randomly selected kart order. This session will determine the starting grid for race one based on best lap times. Race two's starting grid will be based upon the inverted finishing order of race one. Race three's starting grid will be determined by race one and race two's total points scored on a 10-0 scoring system based on the finishing positions.

Points Structure

Each of the three races will be scored for the rounds total points. Race winners are awarded 14 points, second place 12 points with 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 and 0 point for third through eleventh place respectively. The driver achieving the fastest lap in each race will pick up an extra point. The best five out of the six rounds will count toward the league championship points.

Weight Classes

All drivers are required to weigh in prior to the start of the league. Each league will be broken down into different weight classes with a driver carrying weight in their kart up to the max weight set for that class. This will ensure a fair and competitive race.

League Finals

The top three drivers from each weight class will receive awards. The top eight drivers in each weight class will be invited back to the Final Championship Race. All drivers must have competed in five rounds. The fee for the finals is not included in the price for the league.
